This mandolin is one of two surviving from the Stradivari workshop. The current pegbox is modeled after one of the patterns on display in the Museo del Violino, since the original was lost, though the original neck survives.

Stringing: five double courses

Soundboard: spruce

Bowl: maple and oak.
