

Reunion in Cremona. September 21st 2019-October 18th 2020

Eight extraordinary instruments by the greatest violinmakers of the past and one special bow attributed to Antonio Stradivari are on display at the Museo del Violino within the exhibition "Reunion in Cremona". These masterpieces arrived at the Museo del Violino from the National Music Museum of Vermillion, South Dakota that will be renovated this year. The Museum chose Cremona, birthplace of these incredible instruments, to house them until the renovation work is done.

The National Music Museum is the home of more than 15.000 pieces and this is why they decided to renovate the museum and add to it a Center of Preservation and Research.
